Signs of labour exploitation:

- √ No written employment contract
- √ Long working days without a separate agreement, lots of weekend and night time work
- √ Not enough breaks
- Inadequate records of working hours
- √ Incorrect worker/employer information on VALTTI card
- √ Too many persons in the same shared accommodation
- √ The worker has paid to get the job, or the worker is in debt to the recruiter or employer
- √ The employer charges for commutina and/or accommodation
- The worker's passport or other personal documents are held by the employer
- CEDILIP CHICLISH, LATVIESU, POLSTA √ The worker does not know the terms and conditions of employment in the construction industry, or their own employment relationship
